In order to take the program, the student must show eligibility for Reading 125 or higher on a qualifying exam OR have passed college level English with a grade of “C” or better. The following classes are required to complete the Basic Medical Coding & Billing Program at Wright College, 4300 N. Narragansett, Chicago, IL 60634:

4. Keyboarding I, Alphabetical or test out at 30 WPM*
5. Keyboarding IIA, Numeric Keypad or test out at 8,000 KSPH*

7. MS Word Part I*
8. MS Excel Part I*
9. Introduction to Coding
